**Communities Partnering 4 Peace (CP4P) to Host Citywide
'March to the Polls' in Support of Community Violence Intervention**

CHICAGO, October 21, 2024— Communities Partnering 4 Peace (CP4P), a coalition of 15 local Chicago organizations focused on decreasing gun violence, will host a citywide “March to the Polls” event tomorrow, Tuesday, October 22, 2024. Community Violence Intervention (CVI) leaders, community leaders, residents, and supporters will march from 15 locations throughout the city to their nearest early voting site, as part of an effort to increase civic engagement within Chicago neighborhoods most affected by gun violence. Key neighborhoods include Austin, Garfield Park, Humboldt Park, Englewood, Little Village and Back of the Yards.
