1 CVI coverage grew between 2018-2025



2 CVI areas accounted for **78%** of Chicago's homicide decline



Since 2021, **areas with CVI drove citywide gun violence reductions.**

3 The "hottest" areas are getting safer



Peacekeepers Program "hot spots" experienced **32% fewer shootings** in 2025 compared to 2024.¹
